Role	Vocal Range/Age	Description
Sweeney Todd	Baritone; 40s-50s	Sullen and brooding, he seeks vengeance for the life that was stolen from him.
Mrs. Lovett	Contralto; 40s-50s	A cheerful but amoral proprietress of a meat pie shop. Todd's former landlady who has been enamored with him for years.
Anthony Hope	Tenor; 20s-30s	Cheerful and brimming with youthful optimism. A sailor who falls instantly in love with Johanna.
Johanna	Soprano; 18+	Todd's beautiful daughter who was raised by the Judge as his ward.
Tobias Ragg	Tenor; 13+	A simpleton indentured by Pirelli. He later works under Mrs. Lovett but remains suspicious of Todd. Would consider adults or youths 13+.
Judge Turpin	Baritone/Bass; 40s-60s	A corrupt judge who is first infatuated with Lucy Barker, but later turns his obsession to Johanna.
The Beadle	Tenor; 30s-50s	Judge Turpin's right-hand man; a corrupt public official.
Beggar Woman	Mezzo-Soprano; 30s-40s	A mad crone whose warnings of mischief are ignored by the London people.
Adolf Pirelli	Tenor; 30s-40s	A former employee of Benjamin Barker. He's now a con-artist taking on the persona of a flashy Italian barber.
Ensemble	All Vocal Parts; 18+	Men and women of London, customers, lunatics, clean-shaven victims, etc.

Directed by Matthew Scott Campbell.

Auditions open for men and women age 18 and up, and one boy age 13 and up.

Auditionees should prepare 30 sec. to 1 min. of singing with accompaniment (pianist, CD player, and 1/8" input—headphone—cable will be provided).

If called back, sides will be provided after auditions.

First-time auditionees are welcome, no experience necessary.
